

Session Notes

As you know Pastor Josh and his family will be moving to Indianapolis in December. As we are saying goodbye to the Cole family in these next few weeks, the session is already prayerfully working toward a plan for transition in pastoral leadership. Here are the steps that we as a congregation will take over the next few months:

- 1. The session will search for an interim pastor. This full time pastor will provide preaching and pastoral care while we seek a new pastor.
- 2. Prior to finding the interim, we will be served on Sunday mornings by ministers who live within a drive's distance to Haywood County. During this pulpit supply period the session will ensure that pastoral care is provided to our membership. In addition, there are a number of areas that you may be asked to assist.
- 3. A Pastoral Nominating Committee will be formed prior to Pastor Josh's departure. This committee, elected by the congregation, will prayerfully seek God's will for the next pastor of Providence Church. The session will set forth names for this committee during a congregational meeting. In addition, nominations can be made from the floor for any member to serve (please make sure you have talked to someone about their willingness before nominating them). This committee will work with the Ministerial Committee of the Presbytery of the Southeast to carry out its work.

The session desires to keep communication completely open with the congregation. If you have any questions at all, please ask! In addition, we would covet your prayers and ask that you continue to pray for our congregation. Pat Inglis, Clerk of Session

From the Roes 3-month update



Courtney led a short-term tech team at our mission's Annual Conference where nearly 100 missionaries were able to get computer help and training. Courtney also designed and implemented a more secure network infrastructure at the conference that included an Intranet site allowing the conference to come closer to being paperless while also increasing the security level. Over this intranet, organizers and speakers were able to share video announcements, conference schedule, speaker handouts as well as recordings of the sessions and more.

In September, Krista's bi-lingual Women's Bible Study started back up and celebrated its 15th year of existence. Krista has been the Teaching Director for the last 2 years. This year they are studying the Book of Acts. Last week we invited all the ladies to take Spiritual Gift tests to see how God might use their spiritual gifts to encourage their churches. It was a neat application of exactly what we were studying in Acts.

Courtney headed up another short-term team in Europe to handle security (both physical & technologically) for a conference bringing together workers using technology to reach the Muslim world.

eDOT is continuing to work on several projects including a Bible Concordance app in Turkish that allows the user to both read and hear the Scripture verses.
